Dear Retreat Folk,

As with any of our retreats, we hope to create a fun and loving environment for you or your camper. We are also determined to provide opportunities for our campers to develop leadership and social skills that will promote their health and inner growth. For any retreat that your camper might attend, we encourage you to try to arrive at the appointed time. Check in at the office (the building on the right side of the road after you pass the pool) for cabin assignments and pertinent information. Supper will be served at all three fall retreats on the evening of their arrival. From our "Camp Policies and What to Bring" form on the home page of our website www.campwindhover.com, you can plan what to pack. Please plan to wear closed-toe shoes and leave sandals and flip flops at home! Any medication must be in a pharmacy bottle with the prescription clearly provided and left with the camp director. Leave valuables and cell phones at home, as well as gum and candy. Do bring a water bottle, bug spray, and sunscreen. Do invite a friend who has never been to camp before to register, too!

Your camper may prefer a bedroll or sleeping bag to traditional bedding. Pack according to possible weather contingencies, and pack with it in mind that children will get wet in the creek or mud puddles, should it rain, multiple times. Even in cool weather, CITs have managed to swim in both the lake and the pool, so always bring a swim suit for just in case.

The retreats end at varied times this year. Campers will probably be playing four-square, basketball, or tetherball around the pool close to the time of departure, and their bags will either be with them or in the cabin.
